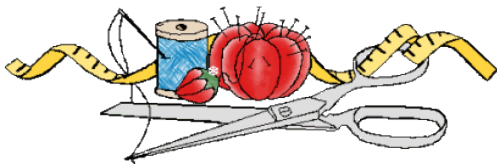


A Little History

Hospice of Ukiah was founded in 1980 by doctors and community leaders who saw the need for compassionate end of life care.

They had a choice—become Medicare certified and funded or a “Volunteer” Hospice. Medicare and other insurance rules would limit the people who could be cared for.

A Volunteer Hospice is completely dependent on the support of the community through donations, and small grants and bequests. But the income from the **Hospice Thrift & Gift Store** is the major source of funds which are needed to care for many patients who would otherwise suffer pain and indignity in their final days.
